

Edmondson Park water lead-ins

We are currently constructing water infrastructure to service growth in the Edmondson Park Development Area.

About the project

As part of new water services to cater for growth in Sydney's south west, we're planning new drinking water infrastructure to service growth in Edmondson Park.

Edmondson Park Development Area lies approximately 35 kilometres south west of Sydney, and was re-zoned in 2008. In total, this precinct is expected to comprise 8,000 new dwellings.

Typically, Sydney Water delivers trunk infrastructure, and lead in infrastructure is delivered by developers as growth progresses. However, in the case of Edmondson Park, the northern portion of the precinct is characterised by fragmented ownership. Due to this high land fragmentation, it is considered appropriate for Sydney Water to deliver water lead-ins.

The project has been delivered in stages, and is currently in the detailed design and delivery phase.

The new water infrastructure includes:

- 1.6 kilometres of water trunk infrastructure.

We are delivering this project in collaboration with Liverpool City Council, who are managing of construction of the pipeline.

What we've done

The concept design for this work was completed in 2016 and in 2017 we negotiated delivery of the project with Liverpool City Council.

In early 2018 we completed design and have now begun planning the construction of the 1.6 kilometre pipeline.

Next steps

Construction is expected to be completed in February 2019. The construction will be staged at different locations to reduce the impact on landowners.

We will keep landowners and key stakeholders informed as the project progresses.
