Job Specific	• Responsible for a safe workplace and work activities, participation in health and safety training and activities, managing and reporting all identified hazards and ensuring their activities do not cause injury to others • Operate the plants in alignment with approved Production plans ensuring licence and regulatory compliance, and approved budgets • Operate the plant in all conditions, in alignment with Treatment and Sydney Water frameworks including health and safety requirements, quality and information management protocols, incident response and business continuity frameworks • Execute on-site process and asset checks using available systems, processes and procedures • Take measurements from installed field instruments and execute lab testing, as required • Perform process and equipment monitoring using SCADA • Identify, monitor and resolve risks and issues during process and equipment monitoring activities and escalate as required • Perform diagnosis and resolution for process and asset issues, electrical, mechanical and instrumentation issues within capability • Perform maintenance tasks, within capability and capacity • Communicate between plants within the Hub and the maintenance provider, and implement planned work • Provide updates to the Operations & Maintenance Coordinator for the Hub Monthly Operations and Maintenance Calendar • Contribute to the prioritisation of maintenance to inform Maintenance and Minor Works' priorities, weekly scheduling, and monthly forecasting • Provide input into relevant meetings regarding onsite activities including utilising online collaboration wherever possible and practical to minimise impact on operations • Manage contractors on site, receive deliveries and test products and materials as required • Manage contractors on site, receive deliveries and test products and materials as required • Review draft and final PTWCs, confirm isolation requirements timing and availability, and confirm the isolation of assets and perform LOTOs for work to be completed • Develop and implement routine shutdown and/or flow management plans for the Hub which minimise disruption & safety risks utilising asset isolation procedures • Apply isolation to assets and perform LOTO for work to be completed • Review Hub KPIs and performance with Hub Manager, contribute to the development and implementation of plans to meet targets • Responsible for maintaining production availability in alignment with operational risk appetite, production and asset plans • Contribute to manage risks within the Hub, including providing input into operational risk review • Contribute to the implementation of business improvement and optimisation projects according to the planned production plan and business improvement project plans • Contribute to site specific operational change management when required • Participate in audits and IMS reviews • Contribute to incident management and response at a Hub level
