

Emerald Hills and Central Hills drinking water services

We are planning new drinking water services to cater for future development in the Emerald Hills and Central Hills growth area.

About the project

We're planning new drinking water services for parts of the Emerald Hills and Central Hills area that are not yet serviced with drinking water infrastructure.

The Emerald Hills and Central Hills growth areas are made up of Camden Lakeside, El Caballo Blanco and Gledswood. The Hills are expected to deliver a total of 3,000 dwellings at full development.

The project is being completed in stages, with concept completed in 2016, and detailed design and construction due to be completed in late 2018.

To provide drinking water services to these areas, we need:

- a new water pumping station to be located next to our existing reservoir on Woolgen Park Road, Leppington
- a new trunk water main that will run down Woolgen Park Road, into George Road and then cross Camden Valley Way.

What we've done

The concept design was completed in 2016.

In 2017, we engaged Diona to begin the construction of new drinking water infrastructure.

We've already completed construction of:

- a pipeline on Woolgen Park Road and under Camden Valley Way
- external building work for a new pump station on Woolgen Park Road, Leppington.

Commissioning of the new pump station is now underway. The planned water infrastructure is shown on page 2.

Next steps

Now that external building work is complete, we can begin construction of the new pumping station. Decommissioning of the existing pump station is due in late 2018. We'll keep landowners and key stakeholders informed as the project progresses.
