#### **Self-registration**

Expressing interest to be a supplier partner

The first step to becoming a supplier is to submit an expression of interest to us. We use a third-party system, SAP Ariba, as our digital platform for sourcing and supplier management. There is a downloadable guide on Sydney Water's website called Expressing an interest to be a supply partner to help you submit your interest.

#### For this step you will need to:

- Complete the <u>self-</u> <u>registration request</u>
- Provide ABN, entity name and contact details

This step is quick, to complete go to point 1 here.

## **Registration**Becoming eligible

Once you have created a supplier profile in SAP Ariba (step 1), you will be invited to action your registration. A guide on our website called Logging in or signing up to SAP Ariba is available to help complete step 2.

#### For this step you will need to:

- Learn more about Ariba (logging in, signing up etc).
- Choose the appropriate account type for your entity
- Read, understand, and agree to comply with our policies and <u>Supplier Code</u> of Conduct.

#### **Preaualification**

Registration assessment by Sydney Water

As a potential supplier, we will ask you to undergo prequalification so we can assess your organisation against minimum competency and capability requirements. All suppliers are asked to complete this process. Please note that we have responded to vour feedback to reduce the paperwork for this step. From April 2024 there will be fewer components to prequalification to make it easier for new suppliers to work with us.

#### For this step you will need to:

 Complete the <u>Getting</u> <u>prequalified</u> step on our website.

### This step requires more time than the other steps.

You will need to upload your certificates and plans to substantiate your competency. Have them handy!

### Onboarding

Getting set up as a supply partner

To become a supplier who is successfully awarded work, you will need to complete the onboarding questionnaire. This includes questions about banking and transactional details. This step will activate your organisation as one of our trading partners in SAP Ariba. For help, refer to the guide on our website <u>Completing our</u> onboarding auestionnaire.
