New dates for upcoming out of hours work in your area

Upgrades at the Castle Hill Water Resource Recovery Facility are continuing and some upcoming work will need to take place outside our daytime construction hours

What you need to know

As previously notified, we need to connect new high voltage power cables within the Water Treatment Plant to support upgrades to the site's electricity supply.

Please note that this work will not proceed on the previously notified dates of Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 September.

Due to external approvals, we are unable to confirm exact dates for this work. **The work will be completed between Friday 18 September and Monday 30 November. The out of hours work will be carried out over one weekend only** (Friday to Sunday) and will occur during the following hours:

- 6am–8pm Friday to Sunday

All other work will continue during our standard construction hours:

- 7am-6pm Monday to Friday
- 8am-5pm Saturday

What can I expect?

All works will take place within the treatment plant. During this work, you may notice:

- noise from equipment such as hybrid generators and hand tools
- noise from plant including an excavator
- work vehicles entering and exiting the site, particularly in the early morning.

We will take steps to minimise disruption during these works, including:

- switching off plant and equipment when not in use.
- planning and sequencing work to minimise noise where feasible.
- scheduling noisier activities to minimise impacts on nearby residents.
- avoiding unnecessary vehicle movements.
- ensuring all site crews park within the water treatment plant.
- completing all works by 8pm.
