Extended Work Hours within Rouse Hill Water Resource Recovery Facility

Sydney Water is continuing to deliver significant upgrades at the Rouse Hill Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF) to cater for the region's growth. This work will ensure we continue to supply a reliable and resilient wastewater system.

What's happening?

As part of these upgrades, we need to connect newly installed infrastructure to the existing network. This work needs to be completed at night when the flow is lower within the network.

The out of hour work will take place within the WRRF and involves pipeline main cutover and connection activities. The work involves:

- cutting and modifying the existing water pipeline
- excavation and pipe connection works
- installation of new pipeline fittings and connections
- testing the new connection.

All associated work, construction materials, machinery and site compound, will be contained within the facility.

Work hours

We plan to carry out this work from **9pm Wednesday 19 August to 6am on Thursday 20 August 2026**, weather and ground conditions permitting.

How we'll minimise impacts on you

We know night work may be disruptive, so we'll make every effort to reduce the impacts on you by:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- directing after-hours lighting within the project site
- fitting equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly non-tonal reversing beepers
- completing the noisiest work as early as possible
- monitoring noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust work as required
