Upcoming night work in your area

Upgrades at the Castle Hill Water Resource Recovery Facility are continuing and some upcoming work will need to take place outside our daytime construction hours.

What you need to know

To support upgrades to the site's electricity supply, we need to connect new high voltage power cables near the site entrance.

Please note that this work will be completed outside our standard construction hours. We are planning to carry out this work on:

- 6am to 7pm, Saturday 22 August
- 6am to 7pm, Sunday 23 August

We are currently planning to carry out this work on the dates listed above. However, the timing may change due to site conditions or approvals. If this occurs, the work will be rescheduled, and we will notify you of the new dates.

All other work will continue during our standard construction hours:

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday
- 8am to 5pm Saturday

What can I expect?

Most work will take place within the treatment plant. During this work, you may notice:

- noise from equipment such as hybrid generators and hand tools.
- work vehicles entering and exiting the site, particularly in the early morning.

We understand that work during these hours may cause some disruption, and we will take steps to reduce impacts where possible. This includes:

- switching off plant and equipment when not in use.
- planning and sequencing work to minimise noise where feasible.
- scheduling noisier activities to minimise impacts on nearby residents where possible.
- avoiding unnecessary vehicle movements.
