Richmond System Wastewater Upgrade project

Continuation of work: upgrade to the gravity wastewater pipeline, North Richmond

As part of the Richmond System Wastewater Upgrade, we are continuing work in North Richmond to upgrade wastewater infrastructure to meet the needs of Richmond's growing population.

What's happening (map overleaf)

We are upgrading the existing gravity wastewater pipeline and installing approximately 50m of pipeline beside Redbank Creek. Work has already been completed along Grose Vale Road, Elizabeth Street, Charles Street, and the rear of Monti Place in North Richmond. The project uses open trenching to excavate the ground along the proposed pipelines, lay the pipe, and then backfill the work area.

When we'll be working

Construction is scheduled to commence from Monday 24 August and is expected to continue until late 2026, weather permitting. We will provide an updated notification to residents if the work continues beyond this timeframe.

Our work hours

Our work hours will be from Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and if required on Saturdays from 8am to 1pm. We will not work on Sundays or public holidays. If we need to work outside of these regular hours, we will let you know in advance.

Vegetation clearing

As the project continues construction of the new pipeline there is some vegetation removal to be completed. All vegetation clearing and pruning will be completed by qualified arborists. All removed vegetation will be replanted in line with Sydney Water's biodiversity guidelines.

Restoration work

Once the above work is finished, all sites will be re-established and impacted areas will be restored.

Equipment we will be using

Equipment used will include concrete agitators, chainsaws, excavators, vacuum trucks, tippers, compaction equipment, light and heavy vehicles, pole grabber, concrete pumps, water carts, generators, pumps, elevated working platforms, mulchers, and hand tools.

Private property access

We will make sure that residents continue to have access to driveways and private properties during construction. If we need access to a Sydney Water asset located within your property, the Community Engagement team will notify you separately to arrange access.

Managing disruption

This work may result in some temporary impacts, including noise, the presence of worker and construction equipment, and increased vehicle movements near the work area. We will make every effort to minimise disruption where possible.
