- 1 Park amenities, e.g. BBQ facilities, playground remain open
- 2 Minimise impacts to cycle paths
- 3 Some impacts to parking
- 4 Construction traffic access and egress route

Greater Parramatta and Olympic Peninsula water cycle management project

We are investing in more sustainable and long-term wastewater treatment, shifting from our reliance on coastal treatment and ocean discharge.

What to expect?

- Construction compound with site offices and amenities, storage of material and equipment for tunnelling (trenchless) construction activities
- We will be in the park for approximately 18 months including site establishment, tunnelling activities and park restoration
- Approximately 7 months duration for tunnelling activities **operating 24 hours per day, 7 days per week**
- Park will be restored following completion of construction
- More detailed information will be included in the EIS Amendment Report to be published in late 2026

Note: Once constructed, the proposed river release pipeline will be located below ground
