

We're installing a new drinking water main in Menangle

16 January 2026

Sydney Water and its delivery contractor, the West Region Delivery Team, are planning to install new drinking water infrastructure to support residential growth in the Menangle Park Urban Release Area.

The work involves installation of a 2km new drinking water main pipeline between Menangle and Menangle Park. The alignment begins at the intersection of Menangle Road and Racecourse Road in Menangle Park. It then travels beneath the Nepean River, through private property before returning to Menangle Road at the intersection of Menangle Road and Rotolactor Parade in Menangle.

Work is planned to start during week commencing **Tuesday 27 January 2026 and is expected to be completed by Friday 15 December 2026.**

We have provided some additional time because of weather and unexpected underground conditions that can prevent us completing the work within the estimated period.

Our standard hours are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays, if required. Work on Menangle Road will need to be completed at night to ensure the safety of our crews and road users.

The night work hours are 7 pm to 5 am, Monday evenings to Saturday mornings. We will notify you before commencing the night works.

We understand our work can be disruptive but request that you please follow the instructions of our traffic controllers, who will guide you around our work area.

Work involves:

- excavating trenches along the alignment
- laying new water main pipelines
- testing and commissioning the new assets
- restoring disturbed areas once work is complete

During our work, residents and businesses may notice increased noise, dust and vibration from construction activity, equipment and vehicle movements around the work area. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise impacts.

Our work will not affect your water or wastewater services.

Temporary lane closure during night work

As we are working in the roadway, there will be partial lane closures around our work area during night work. Traffic and pedestrian controls including signage, boom gates and traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians around the site.

Lane closure will only be in place during night works, with the lane reopened at the end of each shift.

We understand our work is disruptive but request that you please follow the instructions of our traffic management team, who will guide you around our work area.
