

We're installing a new wastewater system in your area

Sydney Water are planning, designing and building wastewater infrastructure to service the Greater Macarthur Priority Growth Area. This wastewater infrastructure will service about 4,000 new development lots by 2029, and will comprise the construction of two new wastewater pumping stations and the upgrade of existing wastewater infrastructure. These works will commence in November 2024 and are expected to be completed by 2027.

Wastewater update

Our delivery partner, the West Region Delivery Team, will soon start constructing these two new wastewater pumping stations. The two pumping stations will be located on developer owned land; one in Menangle Park and one north of Menangle Village. As part of these works, we are also upgrading a third existing wastewater pumping station. These works will help connect Menangle Village and the new developments in Menangle Park to the existing Sydney Water network. This will assist with the transportation of additional wastewater for treatment.

The first of these wastewater pumping stations will be situated at the corner of Menangle Road and Danehill Avenue, Menangle Park. We plan to start these works from **Monday 18 November, 2024** and expect to finish by the end of **2026**, weather permitting. Works will include:

- construction of the new wastewater pumping station
- removing spoil from the site
- increased truck movements along Menangle Road



Work hours

Our hours of work will be from 7am until 6pm, Monday to Friday and from 8am until 1pm on Saturdays. Our work involves construction activities and may be noisy at times. a

We understand this can be disruptive to residents and will do what we can to minimise the impact on you.

How we manage our work

Our works will require the use of machinery that generates noise and some vibration. To minimise the impact of this work we will:

- turn off machinery when not in use
- fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly non-tonal reversing beepers
- monitor noise periodically so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work as required
- All work will be carried out in line with the project's environmental approvals.

Traffic changes


