

Night work at Menangle Wastewater Pumping Station Site

20 January 2026

We're enhancing the water and wastewater infrastructure in Menangle Park to support the growing community. This project is part of a broader strategy to ensure reliable and sustainable water services in the Greater Macarthur region.

As you know, we're constructing a new wastewater pumping station SP1238 situated at the corner of Menangle Road and Danehill Avenue, Menangle Park.

Work is progressing well and is expected to be completed in mid-2027.

Out-of-hours work

Our standard working hours are 7 am to 6 pm, Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. Since 15 November 2025, we have been working extended hours on Saturdays, from 7 am to 6 pm. We'll continue these extended Saturday hours until 18 April 2026 to allow us to complete essential construction activities.

Night Works

Furthermore, we plan to carry out essential concrete works at the night, when the weather is cooler.

We intend to undertake night works for **one shift during the week commencing Monday, 2 February 2026, from 10 pm to 7 am**, weather and ground conditions permitting.

If we're unable to complete the night work in the timeframes outlined above, we may need to return to site the following week for one night shift.

We do not plan to work on Sundays or over public holidays.

About the work

As you are a key member of the community, we'd like to keep you informed on the project progress and how we plan to manage the potential impacts of this work.

All our work will be within our compound area, see map overleaf for our work location.

During the work you may notice temporary impacts:

- Local access for residents will be maintained.
- Solid barriers are in place to minimise noise travelling including site sheds.
- Environmental controls and mitigation measures will be in place to minimise any impacts to residents.

We understand our work can be disruptive; however, we will make every effort to minimise impacts from our work.

Our works will not affect your drinking water or wastewater services.
