

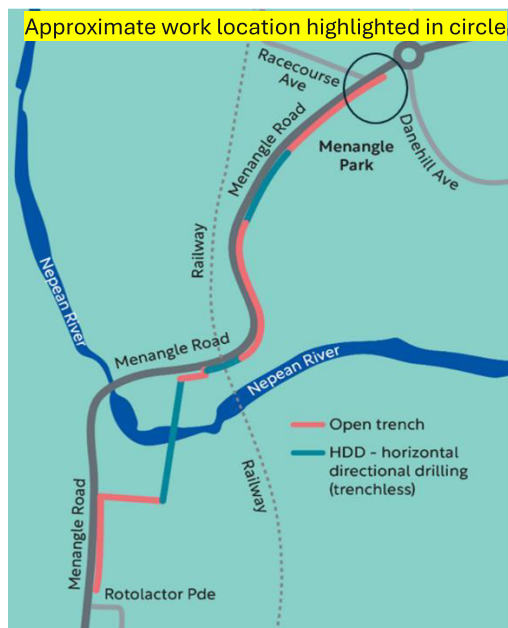
## Out of hours work and work update Racecourse Avenue and Menangle Road

26 June 2026

Sydney Water and its delivery partner, the West Region Delivery Team, are continuing to work along Menangle Road between Menangle and Menangle Park to install the new drinking water main.

### Connections and hydrant installation works

As part of this work, we need to connect the new infrastructure to the existing network. We need to complete this work at night when flows are lower in the network, to minimise service risk and impacts on the broader network. Following the completion of the connections, we'll proceed with hydrant installation works.



### Work schedule

We anticipate this work will take up to two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Connection works are planned to commence on **Monday 29 June 2026, with the intention of completing by Friday 3 July 2026.**

Hydrant installation works are planned to commence on **Sunday 5 July 2026, with the aim to complete by Friday 10 July 2026.** The Sunday night works are required due to conditions associated with working on Menangle Road, which is a State Road.

Works will be carried out between **7 pm and 6 am**.

**Our work involves:**

- Connection and hydrant installation works
- Saw cutting and open trenching sections along section of Menangle Road (near the roundabout)
- Use of a vacuum truck for connection activities
- Restoration work following completion of the work

You may notice temporary increased noise, dust and vibration as well as construction lighting, equipment operation and vehicle movements within the work area

We understand this may be disruptive and will have measures in place to minimise impacts as much as possible.

## Temporary lane closure

For all works in the roadway, there will be temporary partial lane closures around our work areas.

Traffic and pedestrian controls including signage, boom gates and traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians around the site.

We understand our work is disruptive but request that you please follow the instructions of our traffic management team, who will guide you around the work area.
