

Servicing Menangle and Menangle Park

We're enhancing the water and wastewater infrastructure in Menangle and Menangle Park to support the growing community. This project is part of a broader strategy to ensure reliable and sustainable water services in the Greater Macarthur region. As part of this project, we are:

- building two new wastewater pumping stations
- upgrading the existing Menangle wastewater pumping station
- constructing a new 2-kilometre water main from Menangle to Menangle Park

Construction updates

New drinking water main

Along Menangle Road between Menangle and Menangle Park

We've started open trenching at both ends of the alignment on Menangle Road to install the new drinking water main. Following this, we'll begin the trenchless drilling and restoring impacted areas. **Our works on Menangle Road to install the new drinking main will continue at night.** Our night work hours are **7 pm to 6 am Monday evenings to Saturday mornings, with site set up starting from 6.30 pm.** As we're working in the roadway, there will be **partial lane closures** around our work areas at night. Traffic control will stay in place on Menangle Road to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians.

Once the pipes are installed, we'll return to connect it to the existing service. This work will be done at night when the flow in the network is lower.

New Menangle Park pumping station

Corner of Menangle Road and Danehill Avenue, Menangle Park

The underground structures are now finished, and we're currently working on connecting the pipework between them and backfilling the area. We'll soon start electrical work to connect power to the new pumping station. This will take place along the footpath and road verge on Danehill Avenue. **One lane will be temporarily closed, and traffic control will be in place for about 2–3 weeks while we complete the work.**

Upgrades to existing Menangle Park pumping station

North of Fitzpatrick Street, Menangle Park

We've installed a new odour control unit to control odour before the air leaves the pump station. We're also upgrading the mechanical and electrical systems in the pumping station and are now testing and commissioning the new assets.



New Menangle pumping station

Corner of Rotolactor Parade and Menangle Road, Menangle

We're constructing underground structures, including maintenance holes and the emergency relief structure. We're also installing the pipework that connects these structures, and backfilling around the site as we progress. From Tuesday 7 April, we'll begin electrical work to connect power to the new pumping station. This will take place in the road verge along **Menangle Road and will require temporary lane closures**. The work will be carried out during the day and is expected to take 2-3 weeks to finish.

We've developed an artist impression of the pump station so neighbours can see what it'll look like from Rotolactor Parade once it's finished. We've added landscaping and greenery to help screen the pump station and compliment the surrounding area as much as possible.

Work hours

We'll keep working on Saturdays from 7 am to 6 pm at our new pumping station sites so we can finish the project efficiently. We'll continue working at night along Menangle Road to install the new drinking water main to reduce impacts on commuters using Menangle Road. We know our work can be disruptive, and we appreciate your patience and cooperation while we complete this work.
