

Out of hours work and work update near Rotolactor Parade, Menangle

Drinking water project

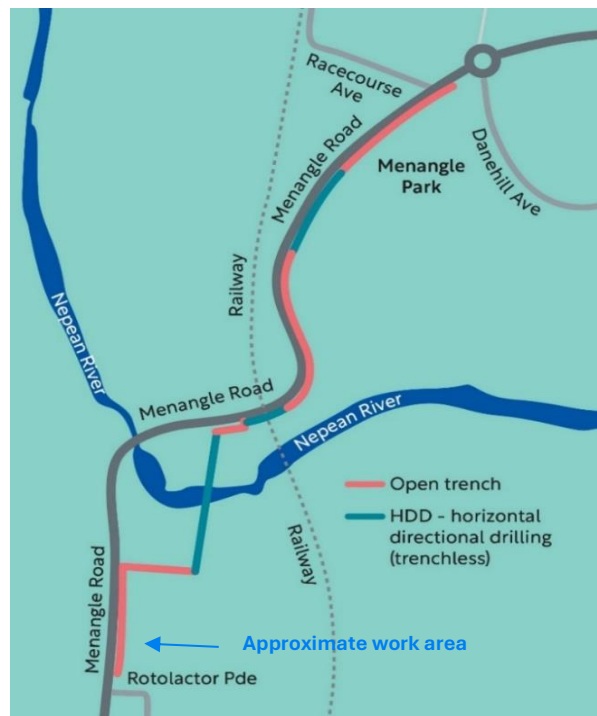
Sydney Water and its delivery partner, the West Region Delivery Team, are continuing to work along Menangle Road near Rotolactor Parade, Menangle. We recognise that our ongoing out of hours work has been disruptive for nearby residents, and we want to keep you informed about our works.

Out of hours work

Due to recent wet weather and variable ground conditions, the progress of the drinking water installation work near Rotolactor Parade, Menangle, has been slower than expected.

We've modified our work program to give respite to residents and reduced the night shifts required near Rotolactor Parade. We're returning to complete the remaining night work on **Tuesday 12 May and Wednesday 13 May 2026, weather and ground conditions permitting.**

Traffic control will be in place at Rotolactor Parade and Menangle Road to complete the work safely and manage vehicle and pedestrian movements around the site.

For any unforeseen reason, if we are unable to complete the remaining works within the above timeframe, we may need to return on subsequent nights.

We'll continue to work along Menangle Road on the northern side of the alignment at night. To support this work, we'll be accessing our temporary laydown area at night, located behind the SP1238 pumping station work area.

Telstra work

As part of the pumping station work, Telstra has carried out associated utility works in the roadway along Menangle Road. In addition to this, Telstra will complete network changeover works at night in the upcoming weeks.

This work is required to be completed at night, when demand is lower, to minimise the risk of service interruptions for residents, businesses and other utility users. In addition, Telstra will be able for the work to be completed more safely and efficiently.

As this work is being carried out by Telstra, timings may change without prior notice. You may receive a separate letter from Telstra regarding this work.

High voltage work

We planned to start high voltage electrical work along Menangle Road from Monday 4 May 2026. This work has been delayed due to unforeseen reasons and is now planned to start in the week commencing **Monday 18 May 2026** and finish by **Friday 13 June 2026**.

Temporary lane closure

For all works in the roadway, there will be **temporary partial lane closures** around our work areas.

Traffic and pedestrian controls including signage, boom gates and traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians around the site.

We understand our work is disruptive but request that you please follow the instructions of our traffic management team, who will guide you around the work area.

Work hours

Our standard hours are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday. We plan to continue working on Saturdays from 7 am to 6 pm, as we need to work consecutively on Saturdays to carry out the relevant construction activities efficiently.

Our night work hours are 7 pm to 5 am, Monday evenings to Saturday mornings.

During our work, residents and businesses may notice increased noise, dust and vibration from construction activity, equipment and vehicle movements around the work area. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise impacts.
