Night work on Mile End Road, Windsor Road and Commercial Road

Sydney Water continues to support the projected housing growth in Sydney's Northwest while providing reliable and resilient wastewater treatment, by delivering the North West Treatment Hub program. The program includes upgrades at Rouse Hill and Riverstone Water Resource Recovery Facilities (WRRFs).

What's happening?

Additional electrical power will be needed as part of our work for the Rouse Hill WRRF upgrade project. This requires upgrading existing electrical assets on Mile End Road and Windsor Road, Rouse Hill.

So far, we have completed survey work and commenced utility investigations, which requires saw cutting of the pavement to enable access to existing electrical conduit pits. We are working day and night so that we can minimise the impact to the community.

Day work (7am to 6pm Monday to Fridays)

• From Monday 5 January to Friday 16 January 2026 (inclusive) work will occur at pit 6, down Money Close, and along Mile End Road, between Hare Place and Withers Road.

Night work (9pm to 5am weekdays)

- Tuesday 6 January and Wednesday 7 January 2026 work will occur at pits 1, 2, and 3 located on the corner of Commercial Road, on Windsor Road and on Mile End Road.
- Thursday 8 January and Friday 9 January 2026 work will occur at pit 5 located on Mile End Road, between Withers Road and Clower Avenue.
- Monday 12 January and Tuesday 13 January 2026 work will occur at pits 4 and 6 located on Mile End Road, between Hare Place and Clower Avenue.
- Wednesday 14 January and Thursday 15 January 2026 work will occur at pits 1 and 2 located on Windsor Road and on the corner of Commercial Road.
- Friday 16 January 2026 work will occur at pit 6 located on Mile End Road between Hare Place and Withers Road.

To minimise disruption to community, work will occur at multiple locations along the alignment, with **no more than two consecutive nights at any single location**. Please refer to the map on the next page for detailed work locations.

What can you expect?

You may see workers in protective clothing and equipment along the roads. From time to time, there will be noise from saw cutting, vacuum trucks, excavators and construction vehicles. We will do our noisiest activities earlier in the night shift where possible.

Lane closures for road users, and footpath closures for pedestrians, will be in place. Please follow traffic controllers' directions and allow extra travel time.


