Upcoming site investigation work and construction activities in your area

Sydney Water continues to support the projected housing growth in Sydney's North West while providing reliable and resilient wastewater treatment, by delivering the North West Treatment Hub program. The program includes upgrades at Rouse Hill and Riverstone Water Resource Recovery Facilities (WRRFs).

Overview of upcoming work

To prepare for essential upgrades at the Riverstone WRRF, we're installing a new high voltage electrical feeder connection along Riverstone Parade and Bandon Road, Vineyard. Work includes:

- Installing electrical cable between Riverstone Zone Substation located on Bourke Street and Riverstone WRRF on Bandon Road
- Trenching along Riverstone Parade and at the intersection of Bandon Road and Bourke Street
- Underboring work near Vineyard Station.
 - The entry pit will be located on Bandon Road, approximately 30 meters east of St James.
 - The exit pit will be located on Bandon Road, approximately 40 metres west of St James Road.

Construction activities will be completed in stages to minimise impacts. It is expected that the work will produce some noise during trenching and there will be an increase of construction vehicles in the local area.

Site investigation and temporary signage installation

From Friday 12 December 2025 we will be undertaking site investigation work and installing temporary signage along Riverstone Parade and the surrounding areas. These activities are in preparation for the electrical cable installation, expected to commence in early 2026.

You may notice our team working in the area to finalise plans for the upgrades. Work includes:

- survey and utility investigations
- temporary signage installation
- noise and vibration assessments
- environmental assessments
- increase of construction vehicles and workers in the local area.

January 2026 traffic changes on Riverstone Parade

We expect to commence the upgrade of electrical assets along Bandon Road, Bourke Street, and Riverstone Parade from January 2026 for approximately six months.



During this time:

- a section of Riverstone Parade will be reduced to single-lane
- detours and signage will be in place to help people navigate the area
- · access to driveways will be maintained
- traffic controllers will be stationed temporarily at the start of each stage for safety.

To minimise disruption, work will be staged and we will continue to keep the community informed as work progresses.

Temporary Crown Street bus stop relocation



The bus stop located on Crown Street, Vineyard, before Riverstone Parade, will be temporarily relocated to George Street, between Bourke Street and King Street, as outlined on the below map. This will impact bus routes 671, 741 and 742. The community will be notified prior to the relocation.
