Walking track closure

Upgrades at the Castle Hill Water Resource Recovery Facility are continuing, and we'd like to thank the local community for your support as we continue to work towards a North West Treatment Hub.

For safety reasons and to make room for our work, we're planning to close a section of the walking track along the western boundary of the facility (closest to Wrights Road) until mid-2026.

What has changed?

We had anticipated reopening this section of track by the end of September 2024 and then periodically closing it during the project as needed.

However, we are now planning to keep this section of track closed until the upgrade of the plant is complete. We expect to reopen the track by mid-2026. Refer to the map on the back.

Why are we closing the track?

There is minimal space at the facility. The track closure will provide more space for workers and equipment during construction. Continuing to keep this part of the track closed will help us finish our work efficiently and safely.

What else should I know?

Other walking and cycling tracks around the facility remain open and are shown on the map on the other side of this notification. Signs will be in place to guide people.
