## North West Wastewater Connection –oversized vehicle movement on Monday 12 January

Sydney Water and our delivery partner, Ironbark Joint Venture (IBJV), are building the North West Wastewater Connection as part of a suite of projects to support housing growth, ensure the ongoing reliability and enhance the resilience of wastewater treatment in Sydney's north west. This work is part of a transformative investment to ensure our water, wastewater and stormwater systems meet the needs of our customers now and in the future.

The North West Wastewater Connection will connect the pumping station at Taylee Place to the Rouse Hill Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF) via a new 800 metre long underground pipeline. We will also upgrade the pumping station to increase capacity, reduce odour and install an emergency generator for back-up power supply.

### What you need to know

On **Monday 12 January 2026**, we will be delivering two large tanks to the pumping station at Taylee Place. These tanks are essential for the proper operation of the new wastewater pipeline.

The tanks measure approximately **3.5 metres wide and 9 metres long** and will be transported by a truck as an oversized load. To ensure the safety of all road users, the delivery will take place between **9am and 3pm**, when traffic is minimal.

To help us complete the delivery safely and efficiently, we ask that **all vehicles** (including cars, boats, caravans, etc) **be temporarily removed from both sides of the road** to allow the truck to pass through.

If you're unable to move a vehicle yourself, we can arrange for a tow truck to relocate it, allow the freight to pass, and then return the vehicle to its original location.

Affected streets include:

- The intersection of Withers Road and Milford Drive
- Along Milford Drive to the intersection with Knox Place
- Along Kindilen Close and Taylee Place
