An update about work in your area

We're renewing the water main along Old Barrenjoey Road, Avalon Beach.

This is not just about pipes. It's about water – clean, life sustaining water. Our work will ensure we can continue to give you clean and reliable water every day.

What do I need to know?

As you know, we have been working to renew the water main along Old Barrenjoey Road. This work has been split into two sections:

- Section 1 night work between Woolworths and The Crescent
- Section 2 day work between Woolworths and Avalon Fire Station.

From next week, we will start work to install the section of water main at the intersection of Barrenjoey Road and Old Barrenjoey Road, in front of the fire station.

This work needs to be done at night to reduce the impact on daytime traffic flows. While we're working in front of the fire station, we'll need to close the intersection of Barrenjoey Road and Old Barrenjoey Road each night.

To maintain access for residents at 61, 63 and 65 Old Barrenjoey Road during this time, we'll temporarily adjust the traffic diversions.

Timing of our work



Our work in front of the fire station is planned to start on **Thursday 7 August** and is expected to take about **three weeks** to complete, weather and ground conditions permitting.

Day work hours



Our work in **Section 2** is ongoing and will continue during the day.

Our standard day work hours are 7 am to 6 pm, weekdays and 8 am to 1 pm, Saturdays (occasionally, if needed). We won't work on Sundays, or on Public Holidays.

Night work hours



Our work in front of the fire station needs to be done at night to reduce the impact on daytime traffic flows.

Our night work hours are 8 pm to 5 am, Monday nights to Friday mornings (four nights a week). We won't work Friday, Saturday, or Sunday nights.

Our nightwork in **Section 1** will also continue.

What can I expect?

We understand our work can be disruptive. We will make every effort to reduce our impact as much as possible. You may experience:

Noise



There will be some noise from our equipment and machinery during the work. We will finish the noisiest work (including saw cutting and jackhammering) by midnight, minimise vehicle movements and avoid unnecessary loud noises where possible.

Traffic and parking changes

While we're working in front of the fire station, we'll need to close the intersection of Barrenjoey Road and Old Barrenjoey Road each night. To maintain access for residents at 61, 63 and 65 Old Barrenjoey Road during this time, we'll temporarily adjust the traffic diversions.

An overview of the temporary nighttime diversion is shown on the map below. The diversion will be in place from **9 pm** to **5 am Monday nights** to **Friday mornings** for up to **three weeks**.

Access to the carpark near Woolworths will be maintained via Avalon Parade and the laneway next to Woolworths.

Resident access to 61, 63 and 65 Old Barrenjoey Road will be maintained via the carpark. Traffic controllers will be on site to help residents in and out and ensure traffic flows smoothly.
