



An update about work in your area

We're renewing the water main along Old Barrenjoey Road, Avalon Beach.

This is not just about pipes. It's about water – clean, life sustaining water. Our work will ensure we can continue to give you clean and reliable water every day.

What do I need to know?

As you know, we have been working to renew the water main along Old Barrenjoey Road. This work has been split into two sections:

- **Section 1** – night work between Woolworths and The Crescent
- **Section 2** – day work between Woolworths and Avalon Fire Station.

From next week, we'll start work to install a section of water main underneath the intersection of Old Barrenjoey Road and Avalon Parade.

This work needs to be done at night to reduce the impact on daytime traffic flows. **While we're working at night, we'll need to close Old Barrenjoey Road between the Woolworths carpark and the intersection of Avalon Parade.**

The work area will be fenced off to keep everyone safe. Motorists and pedestrians will still be able to use Old Barrenjoey Road during the day. Please refer to the map over the page for details.

Timing of our work



Our work at the intersection of Old Barrenjoey Road and Avalon Parade is planned to start on **Wednesday 3 September** and is expected to take about **four weeks** to complete, weather and ground conditions permitting.

Night work hours



Our work near the intersection of Old Barrenjoey Road and Avalon Parade needs to be done at night to reduce the impact on daytime traffic and nearby businesses. Our night work hours are **8 pm to 5 am, Monday nights to Friday mornings (four nights a week).**

Day work hours



Our day work is ongoing and will continue as we finish off the remaining tasks in **Section 2**. Our standard day work hours are **7 am to 6 pm, weekdays** and **8 am to 1 pm, Saturdays** (occasionally, if needed).

What can I expect?

We understand our work can be disruptive. We will make every effort to reduce our impact as much as possible. You may experience:

Noise



There will be some noise from our equipment and machinery. We will finish the noisiest work (including saw cutting and jackhammering) by midnight, minimise vehicle movements and avoid unnecessary loud noises where possible.

Possible water pressure changes – Friday 5 and Saturday 6 September



We need to test the operation of the water network before we connect the new water main. Some customers may experience a temporary reduction in water pressure **between 8 pm and 5 am on Friday 5 and Saturday 6 September**. This work will not be noisy, but you may see our crews working in the area. To report an issue with your water service please call 13 20 90.

Traffic and parking changes



We'll need to close Old Barrenjoey Road from the end of the Woolworths carpark while we do this work at night. The closure will be in place from **8 pm to 5 am Monday nights to Friday mornings** for up to **four weeks**. We'll reopen the road at the end of each shift for continued use during the day, as shown in the map below.

Access to the carpark near Woolworths will be maintained via Old Barrenjoey Road as normal during the day, as well as the laneway next to Woolworths during the night shift.

Relocation of street furniture



We will need to temporarily move street bollards and furniture to make room for the work area. Barriers will be in place to keep everyone safe. The bollards and furniture will be returned once the work is complete.
