



# We're working in your area

# We're renewing the water main along Old Barrenjoey Road, Avalon Beach.

This is not just about pipes. It's about water – clean, life sustaining water. Our work will ensure we can continue to give you clean and reliable water every day.

### What do I need to know?

We wrote to you previously about renewing a section of the water main along Old Barrenjoey Road, Avalon Beach.

In December and January, we carried out some investigations to confirm where our pipes and other services are below the ground. This information will help us plan for the work and save time when we begin construction.

### We need to return to do some additional investigations further up Old Barrenjoey Road. The map over the page shows our work area.

Once we've finished our investigations, we will return in 2024 to start construction of the new water main. We expect construction to take about four months. We'll write to you again to let you know before we start.

### Timing of work



Our additional investigations will take up to **three weeks** to complete, weather and ground conditions permitting.

We schedule these investigations at night to reduce the impact on local businesses and daytime traffic flows.

### Day work



We need to do **one day shift** to prepare for the investigations. This is planned to be done during school holidays on **Thursday 20 April** (weather permitting).

If we're not able to complete the work on Thursday due to wet weather, we'll defer the work to Friday 21 April.

Our day work hours are **7 am** to **6 pm**, Monday to Friday and **8 am** to **1 pm Saturdays** (if needed).

### Night work



Following the day shift, our investigations will continue at night between **Monday 1 May** and **Friday 19 May**.

Our night work hours are **8 pm** to **5 am**, Monday nights to Friday mornings. We won't work Friday, Saturday or Sunday nights.

## What can I expect?

We understand our work can be disruptive at times, but we will make every effort to reduce our impact as much as possible. You may experience:

### **Temporary parking changes**



We will need to use seven parking spaces on The Crescent to store our equipment during the work.





### Noise

There will be some noise from our equipment and machinery during the investigations. We will finish the noisiest work by **midnight**, minimise vehicle movements and avoid unnecessary loud noises where possible.

### **Traffic changes**



We'll have traffic control and signage in place to keep traffic flowing safely around our work areas.

### Impact to your services



Your water services **will not be impacted** during these investigations.

### Restoration



We'll temporarily restore the road to allow for continued use. When work is complete, we'll liaise with Council to complete permanent restoration.
