

# We're working in your area

We're building the Prospect Pre-Treatment Plant in Prospect.

This is not just about pipes. It's about water – clean, life sustaining water. This work will help ensure we can continue to give you reliable water services every day.

Sydney Water, in partnership with Suez and Acciona, have commenced construction activities for the first stage of the Prospect Pre-Treatment Plant Augmentation and Upgrade Project. This new facility will provide additional treatment for raw water to support the Prospect Water Filtration plant, allowing for safe, secure and reliable drinking water during periods where raw water quality has been impacted. This essential infrastructure project will enhance Sydney's drinking water resilience by improving the capacity to treat up to 500 million litres of water per day.

Work will not impact private property, or your water supply.

## Timing

Work on site is ongoing and will be complete in 2027, weather permitting.

Work hours are generally 7 am to 6 pm, Monday to Friday and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. We will notify you if any work is planned outside these hours if you are expected to be impacted.

## What to expect

Initial site preparation is now complete, including clearing, grubbing (removal of trees, shrubs, stumps and rubbish from a site), and setting up a temporary site offices. Earthworks are ongoing, with regular truck movements to and from the site.

Starting in September, the project team will begin concrete and structural works. This phase will include the installation of two temporary tower cranes, each up to 50 meters tall.

All construction activities are taking place within existing water treatment sites around Prospect Reservoir.

Once complete, the new Pre-Treatment Plant will help ensure a safe, secure, and reliable drinking water supply—especially during extreme weather events.

## Noise

This work will create some noise from equipment and vehicle movements.



## Vehicles

Work will involve additional vehicles entering and exiting the site from Ferrers Road. Some improvements will be made to the site driveway on Ferrers Road to ensure safety of all road users.
