## Upcoming construction activities and traffic impacts | Ian Street, Rose Bay | May 2026

Sydney Water and its delivery partner Abergeldie Complex Infrastructure (ACI) are constructing a new pump station at Parsley Bay and supporting infrastructure which will redirect untreated wastewater from one of the last remaining ocean outfalls and transfer it to the [Bondi Water Resource Recovery Facility \(WRRF\)](#).

### Project update

We have completed the installation of 3 new maintenance holes on Carlisle Street and some underground wastewater pipes from Fernleigh Avenue to the corner of Carlisle Street and Dover Road. A new work area has been established on the corner of Dover Road and Carlisle Street, and work continues with the excavation and construction of a new maintenance hole and wastewater pipeline in Rose Bay.

The **Stage 4** work continues and includes some minor design amendments – resulting in less activity in the compound on the corner of Dover Road and Carlisle Street. **24/7 one way traffic flow on Carlisle Street from Dover Road to Hamilton Street** will remain in place. This work is expected to be complete by **July 2026**, weather permitting.

### What's happening

#### Upgrade of existing Sydney Water maintenance holes

In preparation for the construction of a new wastewater pipeline in Rose Bay, we will be excavating around the existing maintenance hole on the verge outside of 2 - 4 Ian Street, Rose Bay from **Thursday 11 June 2026 to Friday 7 August 2026**, weather permitting. This will involve the establishment of a new site compound on the road and verge outside of 2 - 4 Ian Street, demolition of the existing maintenance hole walls, construction of new concrete walls and cover slab, installation of a new electrical kiosk and associated electrical work. Once this work has been completed affected areas will be reinstated.

#### Installation of new electrical kiosk

We will be carrying out minor excavation and concrete work on the grass verge outside 2 - 4 Ian Street to install a small electrical kiosk. The kiosk is approximately 1.1 m long, 0.5 m wide and 1.2 m high and will sit on a concrete base. Kiosks are painted green to blend into the environment and are commonly used around neighbourhoods to support monitoring equipment that helps Sydney Water track wastewater flow and levels in the local network.

#### Traffic changes and temporary removal of parking

While Ian Street will remain open to traffic during this work, traffic on Ian Lane will be reduced to one way from Ian Street to Carlisle Street. Approximately seven car spaces located outside 2 - 4, 7 - 9 and 11 Ian Street will be temporarily removed, with "no parking" enforced in these areas.

The "no parking" zones will be clearly marked with traffic barriers and signs, indicating the dates when restrictions apply. We'll reopen these parking spaces once the work is done. For everyone's safety, traffic control and signage will be in place to protect our crew, residents, and road users.

## To minimise impacts we will be

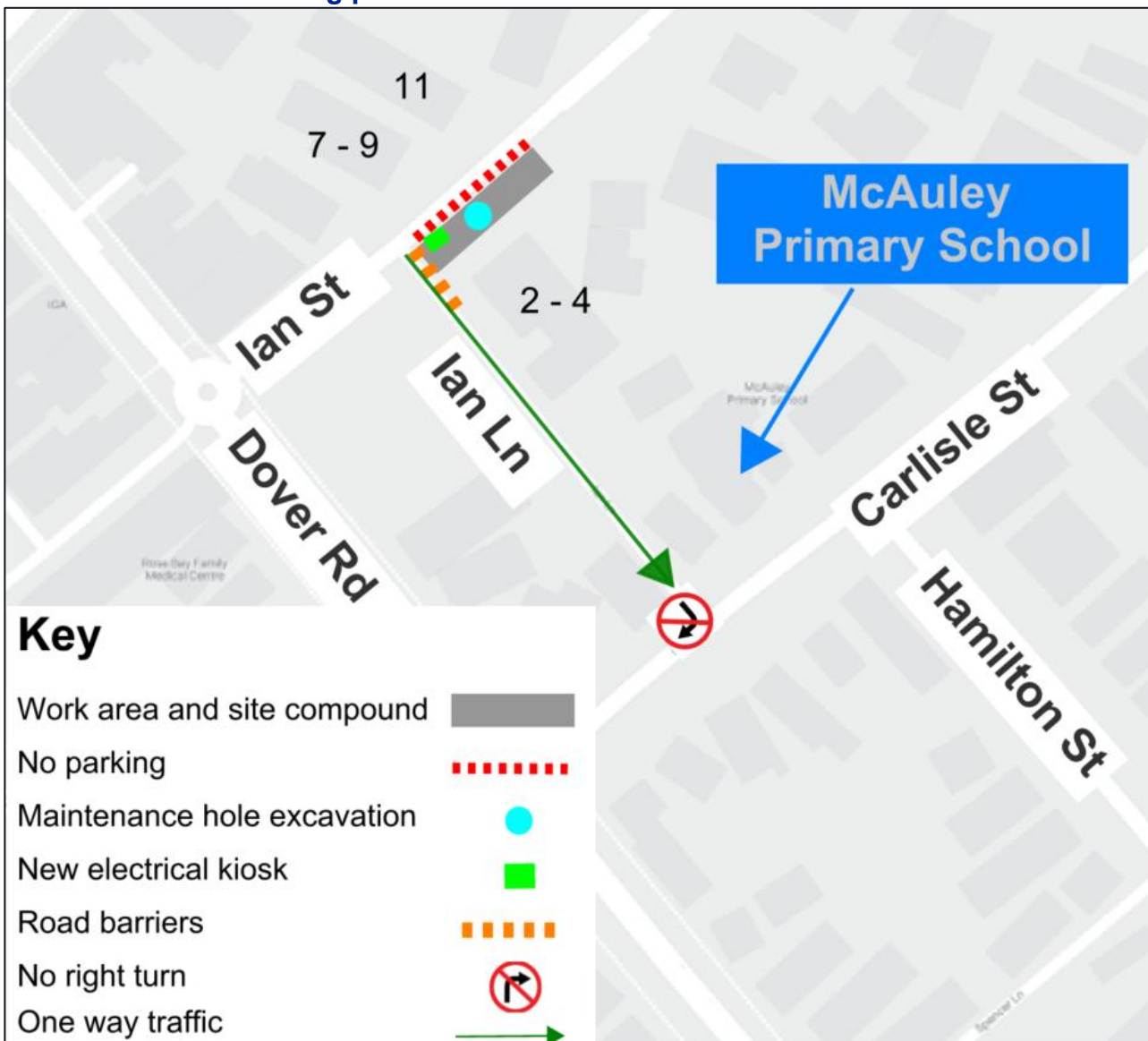
- turning off machinery when not in use and have exclusion zones around work areas.
