Refresh Vaucluse Diamond Bay Project
Eastern Reserve Pump Station
Community Information session

Below the cliffs of Vaucluse and Diamond Bay, untreated wastewater flows directly into the ocean. It's time for change and we're continuing to work to ensure this iconic area of Sydney gets the blue backyard it deserves. The project will redirect wastewater from two of Sydney's last remaining ocean outfalls at Diamond Bay to the Bondi Wastewater Recovery Facility to be treated and safely released into the ocean.

Saturday 12 April 2025 at Eastern Reserve 10am – 12 noon.

Please come along and learn more about the new pump station design.

After receiving community and stakeholder feedback, we have been working on re-designing the pump station to further minimise visual impact on community, the reserve and walking track.

Changes in the design include:

- constructing the pump station underground, reducing the footprint
- placing the underground pump station closer to the entry at Eastern Avenue, leaving more space for community activities
- removing the emergency storage tank from Eastern Reserve
- combining the vent shaft with a clifftop light pole - so only one structure is required
- more landscaping to blend the infrastructure with the local environment.
