## Parsley Bay construction activities and traffic impacts | Parsley Road and Fitzwilliam Road

Sydney Water and its delivery partner Abergeldie Complex Infrastructure (ACI) are constructing a new pump station at Parsley Bay and supporting infrastructure which will redirect untreated wastewater from one of the last remaining ocean outfalls and transfer it to the Bondi treatment plant. Under the Refresh Vaucluse Diamond Bay project, we are building new infrastructure to divert the flows from the last three remaining ocean outfalls in Sydney to the Bondi Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF).

Further to our notification on 20 January 2026, the electrical service installation at the intersection of Parsley Road and Fitzwilliam Road has been rescheduled to be carried out from **Monday 23 March to Thursday 2 April 2026**.

### What's happening

#### Service installation on Parsley Road and Fitzwilliam Road

To prepare for the construction of the pump station at Parsley Bay, we will be installing high voltage power cables through existing conduits along Parsley Road and Fitzwilliam Road. This work will involve pulling cables through underground pits and conduits using specialised equipment. There will be an increase in construction vehicles and equipment around the work area. Once completed, all work areas will be reinstated.

Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of our crew, residents and road users.

#### Temporary removal of parking on Parsley Road and Fitzwilliam Road

During cable pulling Parsley Road will **remain open** to traffic. Approximately 10 parking spaces on the western and eastern side of Parsley Road and approximately 5 spaces on Fitzwilliam Road will be **temporarily removed** from **Monday 23 March to Thursday 2 April 2026**. This will provide safe access to road users and maintain traffic flow during the work. Areas of 'no parking' will be clearly delineated with traffic barriers and signs advising the applicable dates.

A map is provided overleaf showing work areas and suggested pedestrian detours during this work.

### Equipment

Equipment and machinery to be used for the work may include:

- cable winch and drum stand
- vacuum truck
- excavator (for small trench/pit adjustments if required)
- trucks and utility vehicles.

### To minimise impacts we will

- limit the duration of higher noise activities as much as possible
- turning off machinery when not in use
- reinstate pedestrian access to the reserve promptly on completion of the work.

We understand ongoing construction can be challenging for residents and sincerely appreciate your patience during this time.

## Work hours

Our work hours will be from **Monday to Friday, between 7 am to 6 pm** and on **Saturdays between 8 am to 1 pm**. If we need to work outside these hours, we will notify residents in advance.
