

## Refresh Vaucluse Diamond Bay Project

Below the cliffs of Vaucluse and Diamond Bay, wastewater flows directly into the ocean untreated. It's time for change and we're continuing to work to ensure this iconic area of Sydney gets the clean, blue backyard it deserves. Under the Refresh Vaucluse Diamond Bay project, we are building new infrastructure to divert the flows from the last three remaining ocean outfalls in Sydney to the Bondi Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF).

### Project update

At the beginning of February 2025, drilling work started for the new 1.8km wastewater pipeline from the Parsley Bay Reserve car park to Carlisle Street, Rose Bay. The underground drill will reach the surface at Carlisle Street in the coming weeks with the remainder of the pipeline alignment on Carlisle Street to be trenched where it will connect with the existing wastewater network that goes to the Bondi WRRF.

**From Monday 31 March** we will be starting work to dig the drill exit pit, complete trenching work and then install the new pipes from Carlisle Street to Parsley Bay. For the safety of the pedestrians, motorists and the community, some changes to traffic and parking are required on Carlisle Street and the surrounding area while this work is being completed. The work will be completed over 4 stages throughout the next 12 months. This notification provides information on stage 1 and 2.

### Carlisle Street work - stage 1

**Work activities from 31 March 2025 includes:**

- Site compound establishment
- Site set up for underground pipe exit pit on Carlisle Street
- Temporary removal of approximately 15 parking spaces on Carlisle Street.
- Relocation of accessible parking space about 10 metres towards Fernleigh Avenue.

We understand this work may impact the local community and thank you for your patience and understanding while we complete this important work.

Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists around the work sites.



## Carlisle Street work - stage 2


### Traffic changes and construction work Carlisle Street, Rose Bay

**Work activities from April 2025 include:**

- Digging an exit pit for the underground drill in the road.
- Establishing a site compound for equipment.
- Installing underground pipes from Carlisle Street to Parsley Bay
- Temporary removal of an additional (approximately 12) car spaces.

**Stage 2 temporary traffic impacts Monday – Friday between 7am – 6pm**

- One way traffic only, eastbound from 33 Carlisle Street to Fernleigh Avenue
- No right turn from Conway Avenue to Carlisle Street
- No left turn northbound from Fernleigh Avenue to Carlisle Street
- No left turn westbound from Chamberlain Avenue to Carlisle Street.



### Important information

- Parking will be removed on both sides of Carlisle Street (from 33 Carlisle Street to Fernleigh Avenue intersection) to allow work to be completed safely. Spaces will be reinstated when work is completed.
- Two-way traffic on Carlisle Street will be reinstated each weekday after 6pm and on the weekends.
- Traffic control, signage, detours and digital message boards will be in place on Carlisle Street and the area to direct road users and for the safety of our crew, residents and road users.
- The footpaths along Carlisle Street will remain open for pedestrians at all times.
- Driveways will remain open for local resident access on Carlisle Street.

**Our work hours are Monday to Friday, from 7 am to 6 pm.** Traffic can flow through Carlisle Street outside of these hours.
