SITE INVESTIGATIONS

The population in the North Richmond catchment is projected to grow significantly over the next 30 years. Sydney Water is working to upgrade the wastewater infrastructure in North Richmond to meet the servicing needs of the growing population and regulatory requirements.

Service Locating and Geotechnical Investigation

Sydney Water and its delivery partner BMD will be continuing site investigations in the North Richmond area (please refer to the map overleaf) to better understand ground conditions. We will be working predominantly in the road corridor along the alignment shown on the map.

Service locating involves identifying and marking utilities (water pipes, gas and electrical lines) within our alignment. Accurate service locating helps prevent accidental damage during construction and excavation. **Geotechnical investigation** involves assessing the soil and subsurface conditions to prepare for construction. This investigation informs foundation design, slope stability and overall project safety.

We plan to start investigation work on **Monday 1 July 2024** and expect to finish by **late August 2024**, weather permitting. Our work hours will be from **7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday** and from **8 am to 1 pm on Saturday**. No work is planned for Sundays or public holidays.

What you need to know

We know our work can be disruptive, so we'll make every effort to reduce any impact this work may have on you. You may experience:

Noise



During work hours moderate noise levels may be emitted due to construction machinery. No heavy noise activities are planned.

Parking



Some parking may be disrupted due to construction vehicles and work zones. Driveway access will be maintained throughout.

Traffic



Our machinery and trucks may take space up on the street. Traffic controllers will help traffic flow while keeping you and our team safe. Allowances will be made for emergency vehicle access during this time.

Private property access

We will make sure that residents continue to have access to all driveways and private properties during this time. If we need access to your property, we will notify you separately to arrange access.





Service locating and geotechnical investigation activities will be within the area above.

Traffic Management

To keep both you and our workers safe, lane closures may be in place in different locations. Our work may affect travel times. Please keep to the speed limits, follow signs and traffic controllers' directions. Traffic management will follow our investigation work as we progress along the alignment. In school zones we will work outside school drop off and pick up times.

Restoration

Disturbed areas will be temporarily restored after investigation work has been completed. Permanent restoration will be completed after the construction work has finished.
