Ryde to Pymble pipeline upgrade

Construction continuing on Agincourt Road from Lancaster Drive to Dayman Place and Vimiera Road

Dear Resident,

Sydney Water and our delivery partner, McConnell Dowell–Gamuda Joint Venture, are bringing the Ryde to Pymble drinking water pipeline back into service and upgrading the connection to Wahroonga Reservoir. This essential work will help provide a more reliable water supply and support the growing needs of Sydney's North Shore.

On Monday 24 August 2026 we've started trenching work along Agincourt Road between Lancaster Drive and Culloden Road.

From Friday 4 September 2026, we'll continue this work north along Agincourt Road from Lancaster Drive to Dayman Place and Vimiera Road.

What to expect

We understand construction can be disruptive and will work to minimise impacts wherever possible. We will keep residents and stakeholders informed as work progresses.

During construction, you may notice:

- construction noise during trenching and other activities

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- temporary changes to traffic and access
- temporary changes to on-street parking
- construction vehicles, equipment and workers in the area.

Trees and vegetation

Some tree removal and pruning may be required to safely complete this work.

Trees and vegetation potentially impacted by the project have been assessed as part of the environmental approval process. We'll continue to review construction methods and work areas to reduce impacts to trees wherever possible.

Traffic and access

To safely carry out this work, temporary traffic management will be in place at different locations as construction progresses. This may include:

- temporary road closures and detours
- single-lane closures
- stop/slow traffic control
- temporary parking restrictions.

Traffic controllers will be in place when required to safely manage vehicles, pedestrians and access to properties. Please follow the directions of traffic controllers and allow extra travel time when travelling through the work area.

Some on-street parking may be temporarily unavailable while work is underway.
