Ryde to Pymble pipeline upgrade

Start of construction on Kissing Point Road between Koombalah Avenue and Saddington Street

Dear Resident,

Sydney Water and our delivery partner, McConnell Dowell–Gamuda Joint Venture, are bringing the Ryde to Pymble drinking water pipeline back into service and upgrading the connection to Wahroonga Reservoir. This essential work will help provide a more reliable water supply and support the growing needs of Sydney's North Shore.

From Thursday 17 September 2026, construction and trenching work will take place along Kissing Point Road between Koombalah Avenue and Saddington Street.

This work is expected to continue until start of October 2026, weather, site conditions and licence agreements permitting.

As work progresses, we'll provide further notifications and information about the timing, specific work locations, traffic changes and any other upcoming impacts.

Project alignment

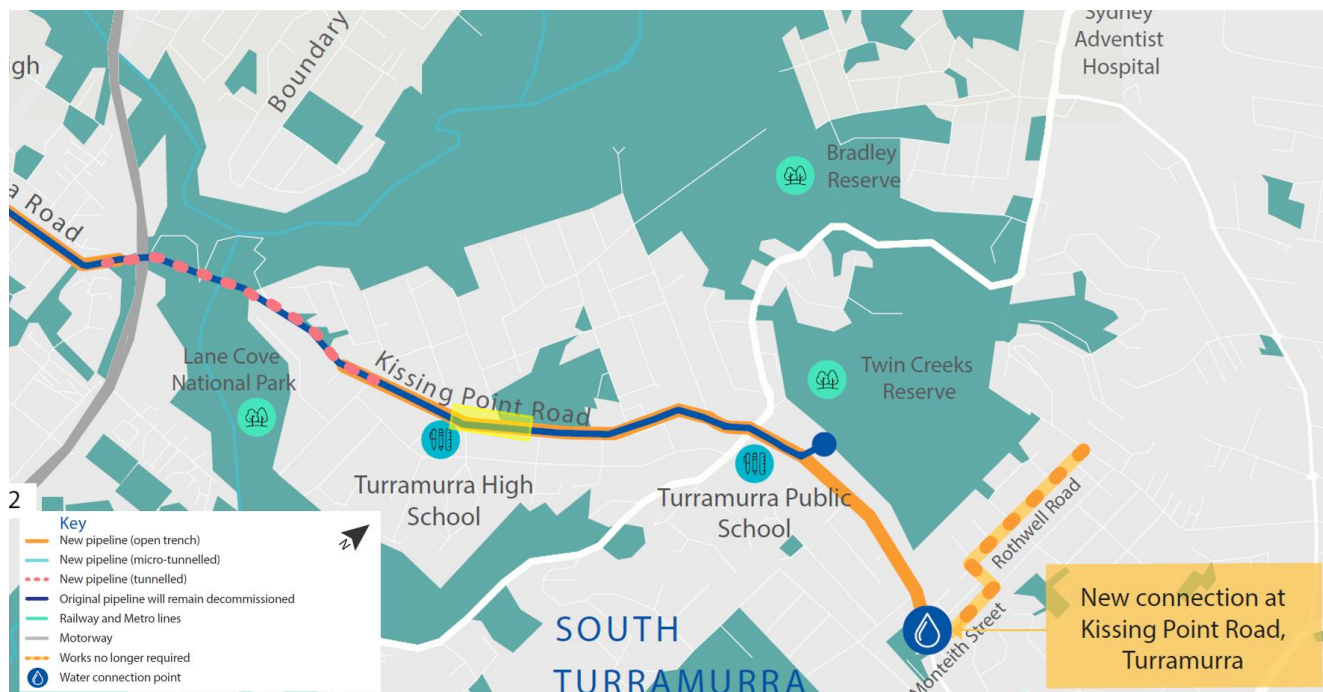


Image: Project alignment. Approximate construction area highlighted in yellow.

What to expect

We understand constructions can be disruptive and will work to minimise impacts wherever possible. We will keep residents and stakeholder informed throughout the work.

Our working hours will be 7am-6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am-1pm Saturdays. Work will not occur on Sundays or public holidays.

During construction, you may notice:

- construction noise during trenching activities
- temporary changes to traffic and parking.

Traffic management

To safely carry out these works, temporary traffic management will be in place at various locations along the alignment. This may include:

- full road closures (with detours)
- single lane closures
- stop/slow traffic control
- temporary parking restrictions.

We'll maintain access to properties wherever possible. If we need to temporarily restrict access to a property, we'll contact affected residents in advance to discuss arrangements.

Please follow the directions of traffic controllers and allow extra travel time when travelling through the work area.

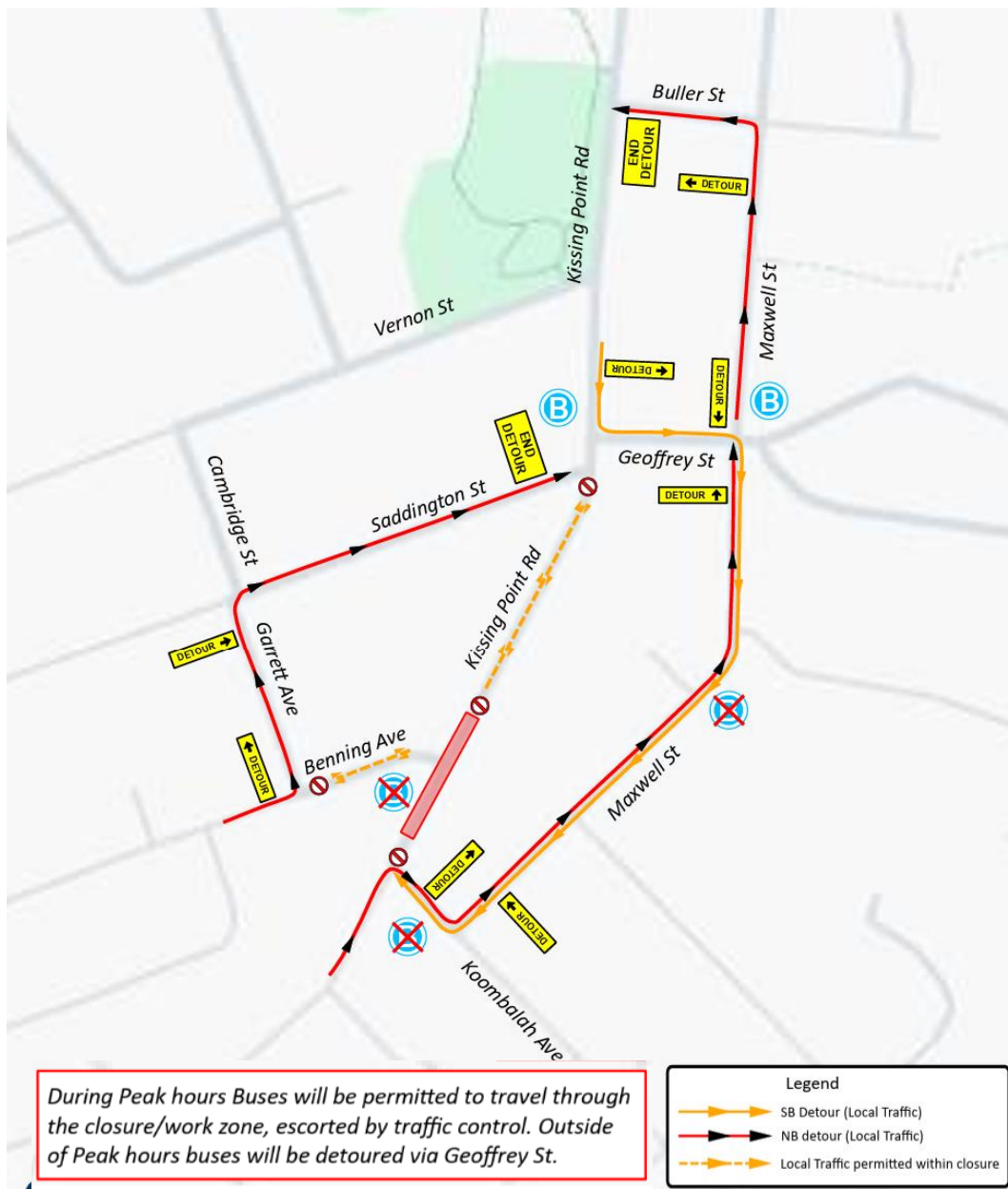
