Ryde to Pymble pipeline upgrade – temporary relocation of bus stop

Sydney Water and our delivery partner, McConnell Dowell – Gamuda Joint Venture, are bringing the Ryde to Pymble drinking water pipeline back into service and upgrading the connection to Wahroonga Reservoir. This essential work will help provide a more reliable water supply and support the growing needs of Sydney's North Shore.

Bus stop relocation

We'll temporary relocate some local bus stops to ensure the safety of passengers and pedestrians while construction on the Ryde to Pymble pipeline upgrade is underway.

Work will be carried out on **Thursday 20 August** and **Friday 21 August between 7am and 6pm**, subject to weather and site conditions permitting.

- Culloden Road temporary relocation is anticipated to be effective from
1 December 2026 to February 2027

Your bus operator will provide information about the temporary bus stop locations and any route changes before they take effect.

What you need to know

The installation of the temporary bus stop will include a new concrete pad and the bus stop sign. A single lane closure will be in place to safely accommodate construction activities.
