



An update about work in your area

3 November 2025

Sydney Water and our delivery partner, CreekConnect, are working together to deliver the Upper South Creek Networks (USCN) Program to ensure that Western Sydney's growing communities are connected to world-class water services.

Over the next decade, we will design and construct wastewater pipelines and pumping stations in stages across the eight Upper South Creek precincts.

What you need to know

In November 2025, we will start site investigations for the design and future construction of the permanent pumping station adjacent to **195 Gurner Avenue, Austral**.

Over the next few months, investigation work will be undertaken within the existing pumping station compound, including:

- topographical surveys to measure existing ground levels.
- underground service locating to scan the ground to identify existing utilities and services.
- non-destructive digging in selected locations to identify buried services. This method uses a high-pressure water and vacuum system to expose utilities safely.
- drilling boreholes and test pits to confirm ground conditions and depth of rock.

Most of this work will take place within the existing pumping station compound. If we need access to private property, we will contact the affected residents directly in advance.

Your water services won't be impacted while we do this work.

Our work hours



Our work hours are **7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday** and **8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays**.

We won't work on Sundays or public holidays.

What you can expect

We know our work can be disruptive, so we will make every effort to reduce any impact this work may have on you. You may experience:

Noise



At times, there may be some noise from the non-destructive digging and drilling.

We will keep noise to a minimum, avoid unnecessary loud noises and follow all mitigation measures.



Truck movements



There will be frequent vehicle movements in and out of the site during our approved working hours. Truck movements will vary each day depending on the work activity.

We'll make sure our workers understand the importance of driving safely and within speed limits.
