

An update about work in your area

3 December 2025

We are building new wastewater infrastructure as part of the Upper South Creek Networks Program to ensure that Western Sydney's growing communities are connected to world-class wastewater services.

Our work to design and deliver the next stage of wastewater infrastructure in the Austral Leppington precinct is progressing.

What you need to know

Site investigations started in November 2025 to help us develop our design and plan for future construction of the permanent wastewater pumping station adjacent to **195 Gurner Avenue, Austral**.

Site investigation activities will continue within our existing pumping station site until **May 2026**. We'll also undertake site investigations on Gurner Avenue and the access road to the pumping station. This will include:

- topographical surveys to measure existing ground levels
- underground service locating to scan the ground to identify existing utilities and services
- drilling boreholes and test pits to confirm ground conditions and depth of rock.

Your water services **won't** be impacted while we do this work.

Our work hours



Our work hours are **7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday** and **8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays**.

We won't work on Sundays or public holidays.

Our end of year shutdown is from **Monday 22 December 2025** and we will return on **Monday 5 January 2026**

What you can expect

We know our work can be disruptive, so we will make every effort to reduce any impact this work may have on you. You may experience:

Traffic changes



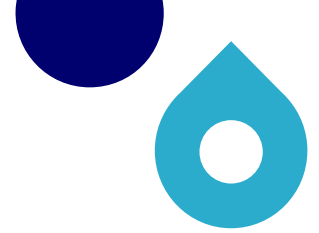
Our work area will take up space on the road, for the safety of our workers. Single lane closures and stop/slow traffic control will be in place between **7am** and **6 pm**.

Please follow signage and directions from traffic controllers. Our traffic controllers will help traffic flow while keeping you safe.

Access



Access to and from some properties may be limited for short periods of time. We will notify you beforehand and help you to get in and out of your driveway safely.



Noise



At times, there may be some noise from the geotechnical drilling. We will keep noise to a minimum, avoid unnecessary loud noises and follow all mitigation measures.

Truck movements



There will be frequent vehicle movements in and out of the site during our approved working hours. Truck movements will vary each day depending on the work activity.

We will make sure our workers understand the importance of driving safely and within speed limits.
