

We're working in your area

We are starting construction of new wastewater infrastructure as part of the Upper South Creek Networks Program, providing world-class wastewater services to Western Sydney's growing communities.

Our work is starting soon in the Mamre Road precinct, to deliver key wastewater infrastructure, including two new pumping stations, 4.5 km of drinking water pipes, 4.5 km of wastewater pipes and 300 m of recycled water pipes.

What you need to know

We have engaged **Ward Civil** to start construction of the new Mamre Road wastewater pipeline along Mamre Road between Bakers Lane and Darrabarra Avenue, Kemps Creek. Starting in **June 2026**, the first six months of work will include:

- site establishment to set up site offices, facilities, laydown and work areas
- clearing vegetation (only as required) and installing fencing around our work areas
- installing road barriers along Mamre Road between Bakers Lane and Darrabarra Avenue, Kemps Creek (subject to approval)
- building temporary access tracks to maintenance hole locations
- excavating, compacting and levelling ground surfaces
- deep excavation work to construct the maintenance holes and enable the underground drilling activities
- open-trenching excavations, to dig the trench and lay pipes
- using underground drilling machines to install the wastewater pipes
- surveying activities, including using a drone camera above our work areas

- delivery and removal of materials and equipment to and from site, which may include out-of-hours deliveries of oversized plant and equipment.

The map on page 3 shows our work areas.

We will engage another delivery contractor later in 2026 to start construction of the new wastewater and drinking water pipes along Mamre Road between Darrabarra Avenue and Kerrs Road, Kemps Creek.

We will also be undertaking additional site investigations along Mamre Road, between Kerrs Road and Elizabeth Drive, Kemps Creek. This work will include topographical survey, underground services locating, non-destructive digging (using water and vacuum systems to identify buried services) and geotechnical investigations. If we need access to your property, we will contact you directly in advance.

Update on Mamre Road pumping stations

Work to prepare for construction of the two wastewater pumping stations is expected to start in **June 2026**. Upcoming activities include:

- site establishment to set up site offices, facilities, stockpile areas and fencing around the pumping station footprint
- general earthworks and placement of imported materials
- construction of a new access road, including excavation, delivery of materials and compacting road base
- drilling piles, installing steel formwork and pouring concrete
- excavation work for the future pumping station
- delivery and removal of materials and equipment to and from site.

Standard work hours



Our standard work hours are **7 am to 6 pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays**.

We won't work on Sundays or public holidays.

If we need to work outside these hours, we will notify you in advance.

Out-of-hours work



Some work will need to take place outside standard construction hours to minimise traffic impacts or ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists, and our workers.

We may have out-of-hours deliveries of oversized plant and equipment between **8 pm and 5 am, Monday to Saturday**.

Out-of-hours work will be carried out in line with the project environmental protection licence, road occupancy licences, and Transport for NSW requirements.

What you can expect

We know our work can be disruptive, so we will make every effort to reduce any impact this work may have on you. You may experience:

Temporary traffic changes



Our road barrier installation along Mamre Road (subject to approval) will take up space on the road, for the safety of our workers.

Single lane closures and stop/slow traffic control will be in place on Mamre Road between Kerrs Road and Elizabeth Drive, Kemps Creek. This will only occur intermittently and outside of standard construction hours (subject to approvals).

Please follow signage and directions from traffic controllers. Our traffic controllers will help traffic flow while keeping you safe.

Noise



At times, there may be some noise from the digging and heavy machinery. We will keep noise to a minimum, avoid unnecessary loud noises and follow all mitigation measures in the construction environmental management plan.

Truck movements



There will be frequent vehicle movements in and out of our work areas. Truck movements will vary each day depending on the work activity.

When needed, our traffic controllers will help keep traffic flowing safely and minimise disruption to local traffic. We will make sure our workers understand the importance of driving safely and within speed limits.

Impact to services



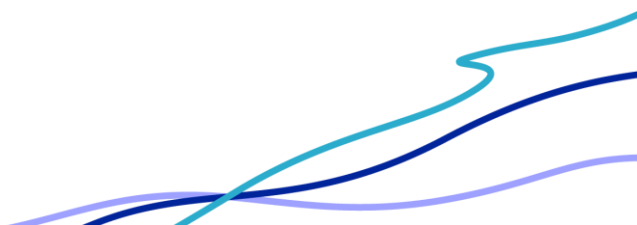
Your water and wastewater services will not be impacted while we do this work.

We will take photos of our work areas before we start so that it is restored as close as possible to the original condition.

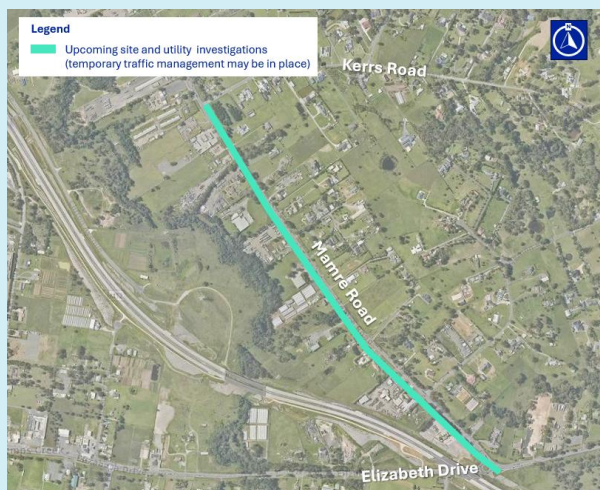
We are working closely with impacted landowners to ensure impacts to private property are managed effectively and impacted areas are restored once our work is complete.
