

We're working in your area

Sydney Water is working to deliver key wastewater, drinking water, and recycled water infrastructure, to enable development and meet future demand in Western Sydney's growing communities. Our work in the Mamre Road precinct includes the delivery of two new pumping stations, 4.5 km of drinking water pipes, 4.5 km of wastewater pipes and 300 m of recycled water pipes.

To meet urgent drinking water requirements for the Mamre Road Precinct, we are investigating the extension of the drinking water main on the west side of Mamre Road from Kerrs Road to Elizabeth Drive.

We will begin survey and visual investigations on private properties in Kemps Creek along Mamre Road between Kerrs Road and Elizabeth Drive.

There will be changed traffic conditions while we do this work.

What you need to know

Upcoming activities along Mamre Road will include:

- scanning and surveying for underground services
- topographical surveying
- geotechnical investigations
- slit trenching to safely access and identify existing underground cables and pipes.

This work will use both non-destructive and destructive digging methodologies, with the support of high-pressure water and vacuum trucks. We will also temporarily require the use of light vehicles, vacuum trucks and lighting towers.

Our work schedule



Our investigations on the roads shown over the page will take place between **Monday 21 September and Saturday 10 October 2026**, weather and ground conditions permitting.

Work hours



Our work hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Our traffic control will set up the lane closures between **9:30am and 3.30pm**.

For the safety of our workers and motorists, some work may take place outside of peak travels times at nighttime, **between 7pm and 5am**. We will aim to minimise out of hours work as much as possible.

We won't work on Sundays or public holidays. If we need to work outside these hours, we'll notify you in advance.

Traffic changes



Our work areas, machinery and trucks will take up space on the road. Our traffic controllers will implement reduced speed limits, lane closures and stop/go (contra flow) to help traffic flow while keeping you safe.

There may be short delays on Mamre Road while we do this work in Kemps Creek. Other contractors are also working in the area. Please continue to travel with care.
