Upper South Creek Temporary Site Compound – Liverpool Reservoir, Cowpasture Road, Cecil Hills

Dear Resident

Sydney Water is building the Upper South Creek Advanced Water Recycling Centre (AWRC) in Kemps Creek and associated pipelines to support population and economic growth in Western Sydney. The associated pipelines extend east from Kemps Creek to Lansdowne and west from Kemps Creek to Wallacia.

Our delivery partner, John Holland, will establish a temporary site compound within Sydney Water's Liverpool Reservoir facility on **Cowpasture Road, Cecil Hills**. The temporary compound will support construction of the pipeline infrastructure through Cecil Hills and Bonnyrigg. We will begin work to establish this temporary site from **Monday 18 September 2023**. Construction of the pipeline is expected to start in the area from October 2023.

Refer to the map overleaf for the location of the temporary compound. This compound location was assessed in the project's Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and John Holland will share use of the Liverpool Reservoir facility with the ProMac project until ProMac is ready to demobilise in early to mid-2024.

John Holland expects to use this compound until December 2024.

The work will involve:

- investigations to identify any services in the area
- installing construction fencing and a gate to secure the compound
- building a temporary car park for light vehicles
- installing site offices and worker amenities
- installing erosion and sediment controls
- light and heavy vehicles accessing the site
- deliveries of materials and equipment
- storage of equipment, materials and spoil stockpiles.

Our standard work hours are **7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday** and **8 am to 1 pm Saturday**. We stage our out of hours work to help minimise impacts for residents. We may need to access this compound outside of standard work hours and we will notify you before this occurs.

We will also coordinate our out of hours works with any out of hours work being carried out or planned by the ProMac project to minimise the cumulative impacts on you. We will notify you separately if activities to support pipeline installation will be taking place outside the compound.

You may notice additional traffic in the area, including truck movements in and out of the compound. We expect that there will be a maximum of ten truck movements an hour to access the compound and traffic control measures may be implemented at times.
