**Re: Wilton Integrated Servicing Program Stage 1 – Hornby Street works, detours and closures**

Dear Resident(s),

As previously notified on 10 October 2025, Sydney Water has begun essential work along Hornby Street West, Hornby Street, Almond Street and Argyle Street, to install new drinking water and recycled water pipelines.

To ensure the project is completed as quickly and safely as possible, Sydney Water has appointed Vaughan Civil and Athassel Civil to carry out the work simultaneously.

**Timing and work hours**

Early preparation work commenced last week with excavation for pipelaying beginning today. Working along this alignment (see map overleaf in blue) is expected to last for approximately twelve months, weather permitting. Our standard working hours are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm Saturday. We are not expecting to work on Sundays or public holidays.

**Road closures**

We understand that recent road closures caused concern within the community, as access between Wilton Town Centre and Wilton East was restricted to a single detour via Almond Street and Picton Road. We apologise for any inconvenience this may have caused.

To fast track the installation and address worker safety road closures are necessary to complete this work. However, we recognise the ‘pinch point’ between Shearer Avenue and Broughton Street, where no alternative side-street detours exist. We have noted the safety concerns raised by the community in using the Almond St/Picton Rd intersection.

To address this, we are working with Wollondilly Council on a proposal to widen the road in this section, allowing a single lane closure between Shearer Avenue and Broughton Street, avoiding a full road closure in this section. We expect the work in this section to take approximately two weeks, weather permitting.

The closures on Hornby and Almond Streets will include detours through side streets to ensure continued access between Wilton Town Centre and Wilton East. Picton Buses have been notified of these arrangements.

Traffic signs, detours and notice boards are active in the area to display this information.

**Property access**

The pipelines will cross some residential driveways. Prior to work commencing, our contractors will doorknock all impacted residents to notify them and implement the appropriate safety and access measures, with property access maintained at all times.
