Re: Update on Road Closures in your area

Dear Resident(s),

As previously notified Sydney Water contractors Athassel and Vaughan Civil are installing new drinking water and recycled water pipelines in your area. To ensure the project is completed as quickly and safely as possible it is necessary to close sections of local roads. Whilst we aim to provide you with timely information about these road closures sometimes weather and unforeseen circumstances can change our construction program.

From tomorrow, road closures will be in place in your area. These planned works are subject to change without prior notice. Electronic message boards, traffic controls, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists and residents. Residents located within closed sections will be provided access at all times and will be door-knocked prior to the commencement of works. Each section is expected to be closed for approximately 1–2 weeks, subject to weather conditions and geological constraints.

From 4 February 2026 – Athassel Civil closures are estimated as follows



Section 2 – Estimated to begin from 13/2/26 subject to Section 1 completion – Almond/Hornby St up to Broughton St closed, detours via Wonson, Campsie & Broughton St. Road will re-open at night to one lane with traffic lights in place.

Section 1 – From 4/2/26 Almond St will be closed for approximately 1 week, detours via Wonson & Fitzroy St. Road will re-open at night to one lane with traffic lights in place. This section will be completed and re-opened before Section 2 closures commence.

From 9/2/26 – Argyle St closed detours into Camden St. Detours off Almond into Fitzroy St.

Hornby Street

From mid-February, Vaughan Civil will be closing Hornby Street (day and night) from Shearer Avenue up to Hornby Street West. Detours via Shearer and Broughton will be open. Again, this is subject to change without notice. Please adhere to signage and traffic controls in place.



What to expect in coming months

Towards the end of March and early April, the pipeline in Argyle Street will be connected to the Almond Street alignment. We are currently seeking the required permits to close Almond Street from Picton Road to Fitzroy Street. The work will be conducted for a period of 72 hours (Friday, Saturday, Sunday), and overnight, with rolling crews working 24 hours. During this time there will be no entry or exit via Almond Street onto Picton Road.

Once the required permits are approved by Transport for NSW and Council, we will be notifying residents in the area at least 7 days prior to the work commencing with the precise dates and timings of these works. Notice boards will also be in place prior to work commencing.


