

Delivering our water future

Sydney Water is delivering a transformative investment in our city to ensure our water, wastewater and stormwater systems meet the needs of our customers now and in the future.

Our infrastructure delivery is timed to support the NSW Government's growth ambitions and is aligned with housing supply policy. New infrastructure, amplifications and upgrades will ensure the resilience and reliability of our water supply for generations to come.

The expansive program of work is being delivered across Greater Sydney, including the Blue Mountains and the Illawarra. A significant number of projects are currently in planning, while many are in delivery or have been completed.

Wilton will experience considerable population growth in the coming years. Development in this area will require significant water-related infrastructure to service up to 15,000 new homes by 2047.

To meet this demand, Sydney Water will deliver essential drinking, recycled and wastewater services including:

- Upgraded capacity of the existing Bingara Gorge Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF)
- Upgraded capacity of existing Macarthur Water Filtration Plant
- 8 wastewater pumping stations
- 1 drinking water pumping station
- 1 recycled water pumping station
- 3 drinking water reservoirs
- 1 recycled water reservoir
- Approximately 87 km of wastewater, drinking water and recycled water pipelines

This infrastructure will be delivered progressively across three stages to meet Wilton's growing population needs.
